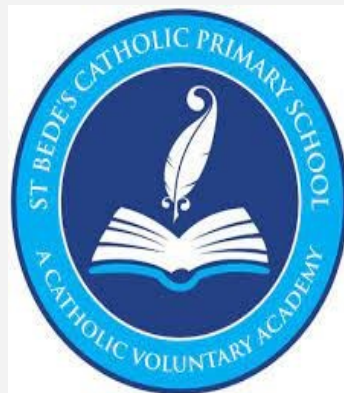

Sacrament of Reconciliation

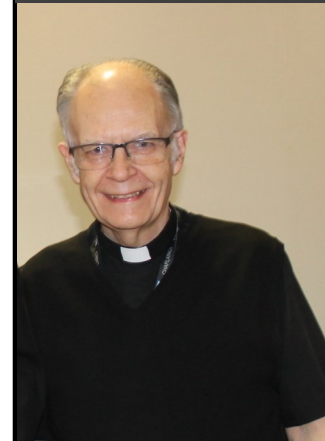
